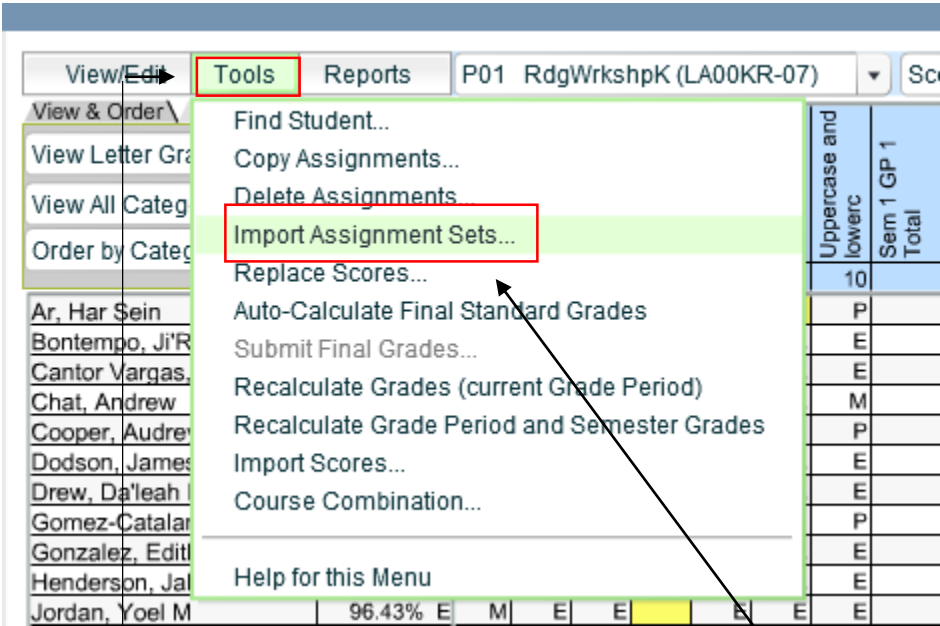
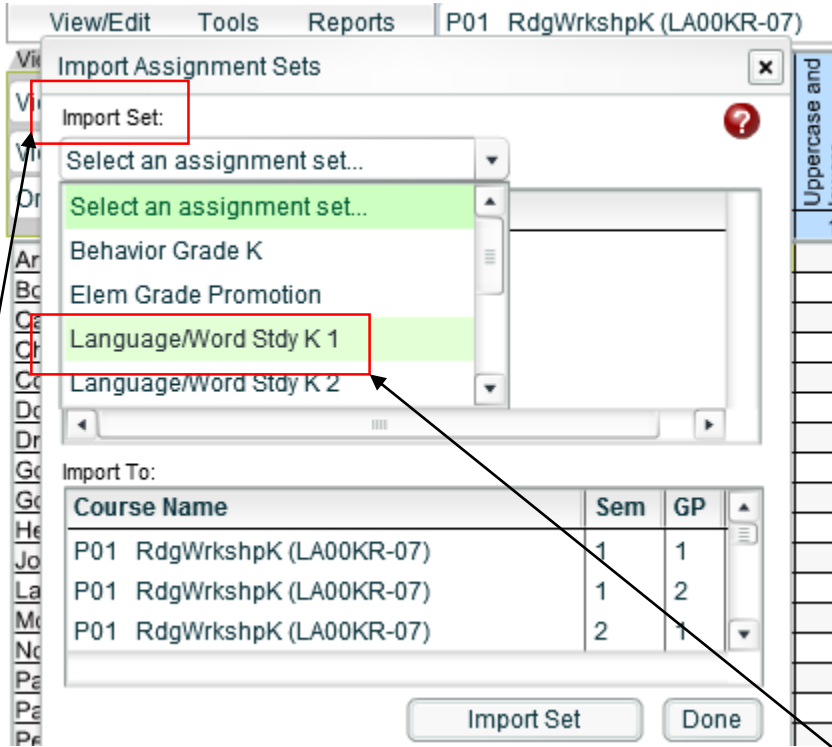

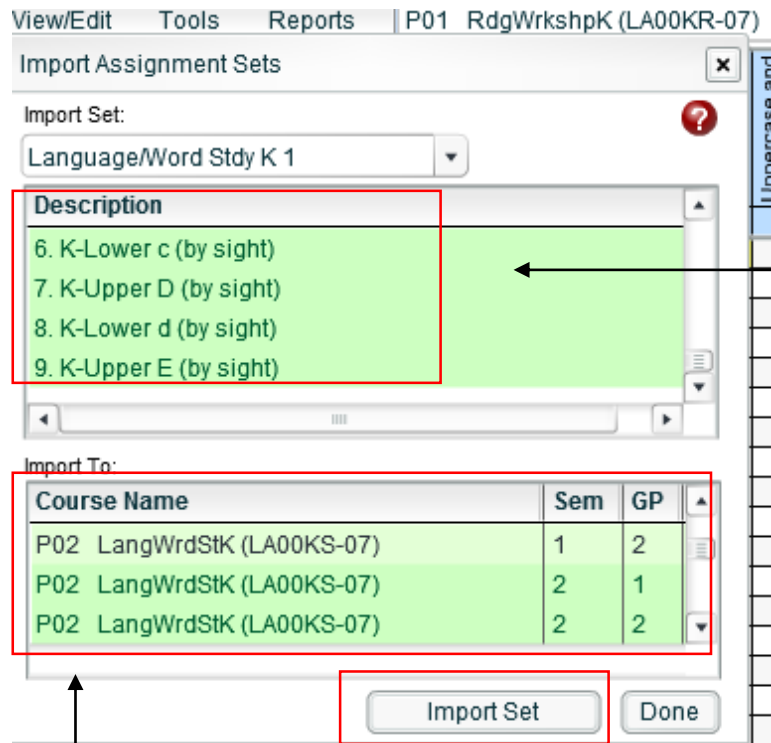

click on **Language/Word Stdy K 1**

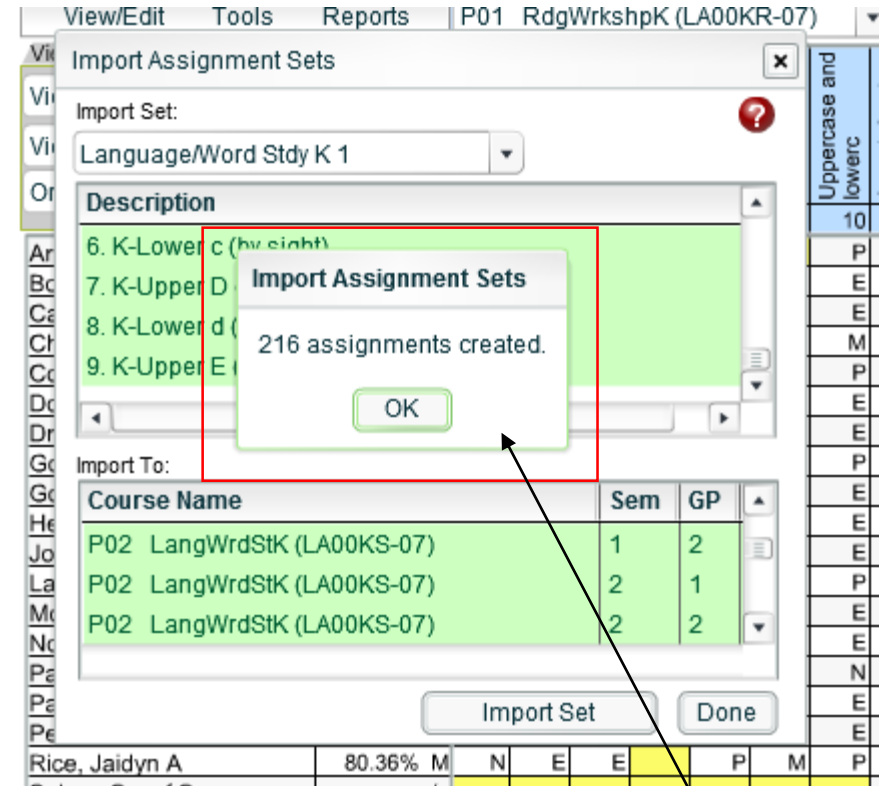



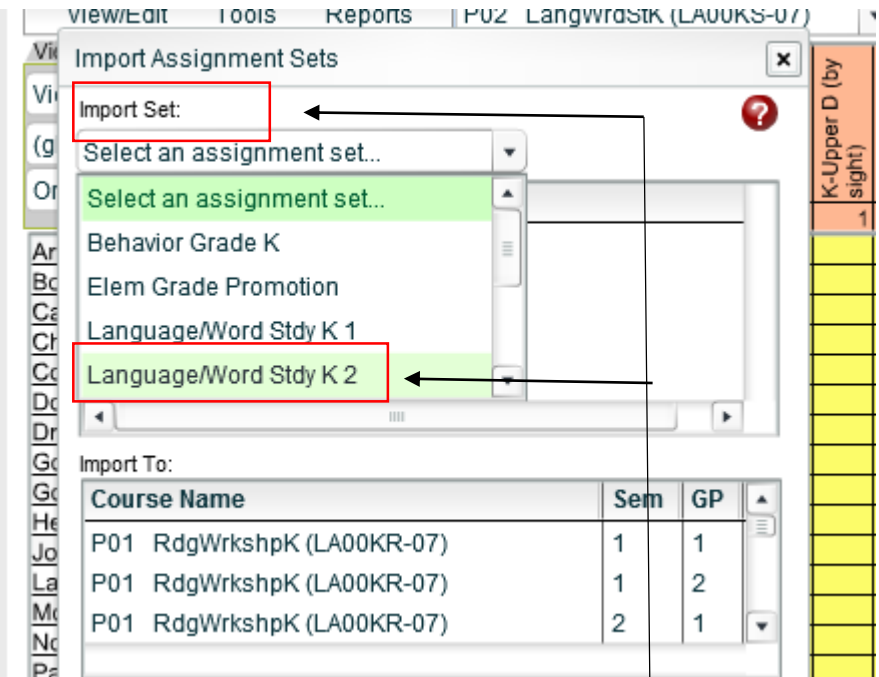

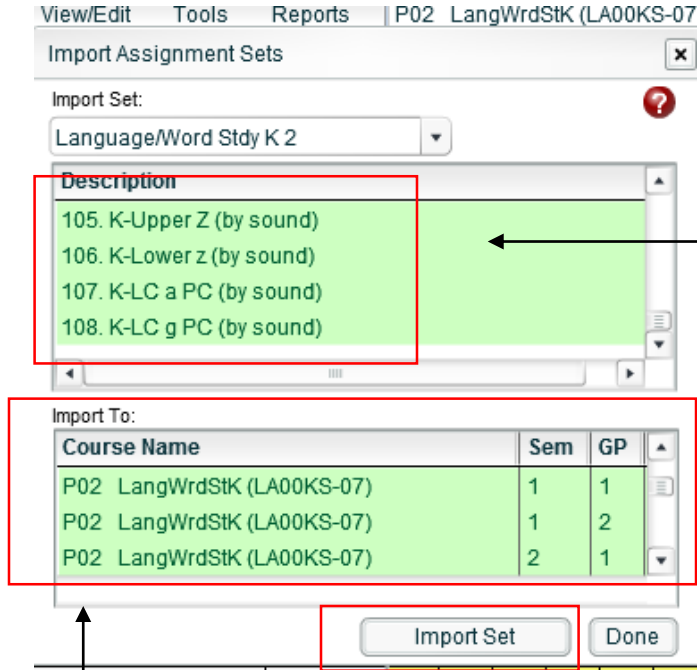
