## CONSTRUCTION UPDATES:

### Cedarville Elementary School - Addition

The domestic piping has been installed in the corridor and work has started in the classrooms. The hydronic piping is being laid on the hangers in the classrooms.

### New Haven High School - Renovations/Addition

The demolition of the four (4) existing classrooms on the north side of the building for the New Administration Area is complete. Work on the demolition of the 2nd concrete riser; and pour slab-on-grade and terrazzo patching for the first riser location in the cafeteria has begun. The erection of the structural steel for the classroom addition has started.

### New Haven Intermediate School - New Construction

The demolition of Park Hill Learning Center building continues, demolition is past the offset north wall of the main entrance. The excavation of the first footing has started at the southwest corner and they have excavated approximately 90 feet east and 25 feet north. A large section of concrete was found at the north end of the west footing which will be removed. The belief is the large hunk of concrete is from a previously demoed school building.

### Southwick Elementary School - Renovations/Additions

The face brick on the north wall of the classroom addition has begun. The structural steel first floor framing on the elevator addition has been set. Pipe hangers in the corridors of the classroom addition have been installed. The piping from the roof drains to underground should be complete in the next week. The rough-ins for the overhead electrical conduits in the classroom addition has started.

### Woodlan Outbuilding

The exterior masonry bearing walls are complete. The underground electrical rough-ins in the building are completed and inspected. The roof trusses have been installed. The split face block is complete on the north and east walls and the split face block on the west wall has begun.
