## CONSTRUCTION UPDATES:

### Cedarville Elementary School - Addition

The classroom masonry restroom walls and the roof shingles have been installed. Electrical/mechanical overhead rough-ins continue to be installed.

### Heritage/Leo - Outbuildings

At HEHS: the ticket booth has been framed; masonry and shell work continues for the concession building; installation of the masonry walls has begun on the football locker room building and the slab was poured; taping and seaming of the interior walls in the baseball/softball building is in process. At LEHS: footers have been poured for the concessions building; footers have been poured and the pad has been prepped for the football locker room building; interior walls have been framed in the baseball/softball building and are ready for drywall; insulation has been installed in the exterior walls of the baseball/softball building; and the exterior doors have been installed in the baseball/softball building.

### Leo Elementary - Renovations/Additions

The transfer of the Cafeteria to EACS is waiting on the roof work to be finished. The installation of the masonry walls for the new gym continues and they are up to roof height on north and south.

### New Haven High School - Renovations/Addition.

The area of the 1<sup>st</sup> concrete riser in the cafeteria is complete, while the work on the demolition of the 2<sup>nd</sup> concrete riser is in process. Masonry work continues on the auxiliary gym, mechanical room, and second floor of the classroom addition.

### New Haven Intermediate School - New Construction

The removal of the foundations/slabs continues with concrete being hauled off site. The elevator pit slab and sump pump pit are poured. The installation of the rebar and elevator pit walls have been formed. The exterior footings and foundations walls for Unit C are complete.

### Southwick Elementary School - Renovations/Additions

The face brick on the classroom addition is complete. The classroom windows have been installed. The first floor concrete slab in the elevator addition has been poured. Construction of the masonry walls for the restrooms is complete; and between classrooms is almost complete. The construction of the new drive is to start during spring break.

### Woodlan Outbuilding

The concrete slab in the building has been poured. The interior masonry walls are 90% complete. The block for the lockers/benches have been installed. The door frames, and wall rough-ins for the toilet and shower areas have been installed.

### Neuhouser Properties

The trees and shrubs have been removed from the property and two of the three houses have been demolished.
