IN THE NEWS:

CONSTRUCTION UPDATES:

Cedarville Elementary School - Addition

The slab for the terrazzo has been poured and grinding is complete. The first finish coat of paint has been applied in the classrooms and toilet rooms. Drywall has been hung. The laying of ceramic tile in toilet rooms has started. The ceiling grid in toilet rooms was installed in classrooms. The installation of casework in classrooms started.

Heritage/Leo - Outbuildings

The slab has been poured for the Leo Locker Room and the first course of block is complete. The first course of block for the Concession Building at Leo has been laid. The exterior walls for the Heritage Locker Room are 95% complete and the brick face installation is to start this week. The Ticket Booth at Heritage is ready for brick. In the Concession Building at Heritage, the interior block for restrooms is complete; the brick is to start this week.

Leo Elementary - Renovations/Additions

The masonry walls are finished on the South side of the gym. The air handler unit was installed on the 2nd floor of the Mezzanine in the gym. The waterproofing membrane is being installed on the exterior of the gym concrete masonry.

New Haven High School - Renovations/Addition

The installation of masonry on the auxiliary gym, mechanical room, and second floor of the classroom addition continues. The masonry walls are up to deck height for the auxiliary gym. The drywall in the Administrative addition has been hung on the stud walls and taped and seamed, roof work continues and face brick has been installed on the Admin. addition.

New Haven Intermediate School - New Construction

The slab was poured for the west half of Unit $\mathcal C$ (classroom addition). Work continues on the masonry walls in Unit $\mathcal C$ with exterior walls close to complete; work has started on interior masonry walls. The steel for the second floor framing of Unit $\mathcal C$ is to be delivered this week.

Southwick Elementary School - Renovations/Additions

The roof on the elevator addition was installed and laying of brick on the elevator addition. The light fixtures have been installed in the classrooms. The exhaust ductwork was installed. The first coat of paint on the door frames was applied. Drywall has been hung on stud walls/bulkheads and is taped and sanded. The pour of the terrazzo in the classroom addition corridor is ready to start.

Turf Fields

<u>Heritage</u>: the soil has higher moisture content than recommended. The wet soil condition was reviewed and the plan of action is to chisel plow the soils 4"-6" deep, let air dry and compact soils and dozer grade area to finish sub-grade elevation. The saw cut work is complete and the concrete prep has begun. The drainage work outside the track started. In the next two weeks the concrete work is to be finished and stone base will be brought in and the entire field covered with limestone.

<u>Woodlan</u>: the excavation of the sub-grade continued and the drainage work inside the field started. The concrete prep started and all of the concrete curb and field events were installed per plan. Issues were identified that need to be resolved to achieve a passing proof roll. The soils were soft across the field due to the depth of the mixed soils and moisture. In the next two weeks complete the asphalt of the high jump pad and start the base stone material after a successful proof roll.

Woodlan Outbuilding

The site storm piping/downspout connections and painting of interior walls is complete. Over 50% of the ceiling grid and light fixtures have been installed where the ceiling grid is complete. In the next two weeks: the concrete stoops and walks are to be poured; begin painting doors and frames; start painting exterior of the building; begin installation of plumbing fixtures; and complete the ceiling grid.
